AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL COOPERATION Between THE HELLENIC SOCIETY OF NDT And THE AMERICAN SOCIETY FOR NONDESTRUCTIVE TESTING, INC.

A. PREAMBLE

This Agreement between The Hellenic Society of NDT (HSNT) and The American Society for Nondestructive Testing, Inc. (ASNT) establishes a cooperative relationship in their respective areas of interest devoted to the promotion of the art, science, and technology of nondestructive testing.

The Agreement sets forth the general principles which both organizations propose to follow as they cooperate in the exchange of information and knowledge in their areas of expertise.

B. MEMBER ACTIVITIES

1. Attendance and Meetings

Members of one organization shall enjoy the privilege of attendance at and participation in, conferences, educational programs, and general meetings of the other organization on the same basis and for the same registration fees as a member of the host organization. Each organization will provide free registration for up to two officials to the host organization's annual conference or main event.

2. Publications

Each organization agrees to supply to the other, one complimentary copy of their official member publication.

3. Membership

Each organization shall extend up to two (2) complimentary memberships to designees of the other's organization. Each organization is responsible for providing the name, address, and contact information of those receiving complimentary memberships.

4. Identification

It is the responsibility of the individual member of each organization, using the privileges under the Agreement, to provide appropriate evidence of membership in their respective organization.

C. SOCIETY ACTIVITIES

1. Observers

The governing body of each organization may name a member who may be invited as an observer to those meetings of the governing body of the other organization at which matters of mutual interest to both organizations are discussed.

2. Communications

Each organization shall provide to the other organization, announcements of conferences, educational programs, future meeting dates and locations, as well as news of mutual interest, which the other organization may wish to publicize.

Each organization may publish in its member publication(s), articles from the other organization's publications provided permission is first sought and then granted by the organization owning the intellectual property. Both HSNT and ASNT agree to follow the terms and conditions of the other organization's reprint policies and to adhere to international intellectual property laws that govern the

creation, protection, sharing, and use of intellectual property.

3. Activities

Each organization agrees to encourage their respective certification/technical staffs to collaborate with one and other in an effort to determine whether or not there are areas of mutual benefit and interest relative to the certification and training of NDT personnel.

4. Exhibitions

Each organization shall consider making available to the other organization, on a complimentary basis, exhibit booth space for the purpose of promoting the activities of the other organization. The size and location of the booth shall be determined by the host organization, taking into consideration the particular event and wishes of the guest organization. All requests for booth space shall be addressed in writing to the chief executive six (6) months in advance of the date scheduled for the event.

D. REVIEW, AMENDMENT, AND TERMINATION

The terms of this Agreement shall be reviewed by each organization periodically to ensure that the Agreement is fulfilling its purpose. In order to carry out and fulfill the goals of this Agreement, both organizations will appoint a contact person for the communication and management of joint activities. Through these contacts, either organization may initiate proposals for activities included in the Agreement.

Amendments to the Agreement may be proposed at any time but will not be valid until they have been approved by the governing bodies of both organizations.

This Agreement may be terminated by either organization within six (6) months after having provided written notice to the other organization.

This Agreement shall be valid for three (3) years from the date of signing. It shall be reviewed by both parties six (6) months prior to expiry and may be renewed for a further term by mutual agreement.

Any proposed Agreement of protocol setting forth an Agreement, even though signed by Officers of The American Society for Nondestructive Testing, Inc. and The Hellenic Society of NDT is not valid nor binding until it has been approved by The American Society for Nondestructive Testing Board of Directors and the Governing Board of The Hellenic Society of NDT.
